MEMORANDUM

TO: Local Examination Waiver Applicants

Act 2010-540 allows the Board to approve applicants who have taken and passed an examination administered by a local city or county the opportunity to receive an Alabama Electrical Contractor License without further examination. Your examination must meet the following:

“(d) An individual who has successfully passed, on or before January 1, 2010, with a minimum score of 70 percent, or an individual who has successfully passed after January 1, 2010, with a minimum score of 75 percent, a nationally standardized proctored electrical examination administered in the State of Alabama, by Block and Associates, International Code Council, Experior, Promissor, Thomson Prometric, PROV, or any other exam approved by the board, shall be deemed to be in compliance with the testing requirement set forth by the board for licensure as an electrical contractor. Individuals meeting this qualification shall also be required to complete all other qualifications set forth by this chapter and the board prior to issuance of an electrical contractor license. Electrical contractor applicants affected by this provision shall have one year after the effective date of the act adding this subsection to apply for licensure without any further examination requirements.”

Beginning August 1, 2010, you may file an application with the Board (**Check “Other” on the front of the application**), providing documentation (**copy of score letter, copy of license and score letter, current letter from the city or county documenting your examination date and score or Verification Form for Examination Waiver located on our web site**) of the above qualifying examination and score, to the Board before July 31, 2011 for its consideration. It is your responsibility to obtain documentation of your examination date, score and the city or county that administered the examination. **Please follow the instructions listed below:**

- 1. Application – Mark “Other” on page 4 of the application.**
- 2. Complete entire application including required work experience.**
- 3. Attach verification of local examination – requirements listed above.**
- 4. Application must accompany a Cashier’s Check or Money Order in the amount of \$315.00, made payable to the Alabama Board of Electrical Contractors. This fee includes the \$165 application fee and the \$150 license fee.**
